- ❖ The provider will determine if the patient is eligible for the Initial **CT Lung CA Screening G0297**
- ❖ The provider will complete the **Shared Decision Making** section within the Note (*this section will only appear in the note for patients between the ages of 55-80*).

Lung Cancer Screening Attestation: Shared Decision Making & Counseling Visit
