“I was gobsmacked.”



Jeannette Cantrell had followed her doctor's orders: Every year, like clockwork, she had a mammogram.

One year, her doctor offered some extra advice: “I think you should go get a 3D mammogram,” she said. “It shows so much more.”

Not long after, Jeannette was diagnosed with Stage I breast cancer. “I was gobsmacked,” she remembers.

Cantrell runs Bardstown Art Gallery; her husband Jim does oil and watercolor paintings and in 2017 is the artist of the official Derby and Oaks posters. Jeannette was treated at the Flaget Cancer Center, and she's now an advocate for 3D mammograms.

“For us as business owners, not having to drive in and spend a whole day in Louisville was a huge help,” she said.
